Business for Good is an impact management program delivered collaboratively between Yellow Edge and B Lab AANZ, the non-profit organisation behind the global Certified B Corporation (B Corp) movement.

The program is designed to help businesses become better and more future-fit, while having a positive impact on people and the environment.

With easy-to-use, globally recognised tools and resources created by B Lab, you'll learn how to:

- Accelerate your organisation's sustainability journey.
- Measure your social and environmental impact through a proven international framework.
- Identify areas for impact-led innovation and growth.



What is Business for Good?

As a result, you will:

- Boost the resilience of your business.
- Reduce risks linked to changing expectations of business.
- Connect with a group of like-minded organisations to share knowledge, challenges and best practice.

Who should join the program?

ACT and Capital region exporters (and potential exporters) who:

- want to position themselves positively and proactively when looking to enter key international markets where sustainability credentials are becoming compulsory for doing business;
- want to build a roadmap to improve their positive social and environmental impact; and
- can commit to participating in the full program, represented by up to two attendees - a decision-maker and an implementer.




What is involved?

Workshops

3 x 2 hour face-to-face workshops to help you assess your impact and build your improvement roadmap.




Completion of B Impact Assessment

The B Impact Assessment (BIA) is a free-to-use impact measurement tool which takes around 8 hours to complete. It's important you can commit to completing this during the first half of the program as it is central to discussions.



Coaching sessions

1:1 consultation with a trained B Consultant. You will go through your BIA and identify priority areas to improve your social and environmental impact.
